

# INSTRUCTIONS: DIY Friendly Monster Finger Puppets

We love our little monsters! You'll need a few squares of felt, some buttons, googly eyes, ¼" ribbon, some glue and embroidery thread and a needle.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Using the monster patterns below, cut 2 body pieces from left.

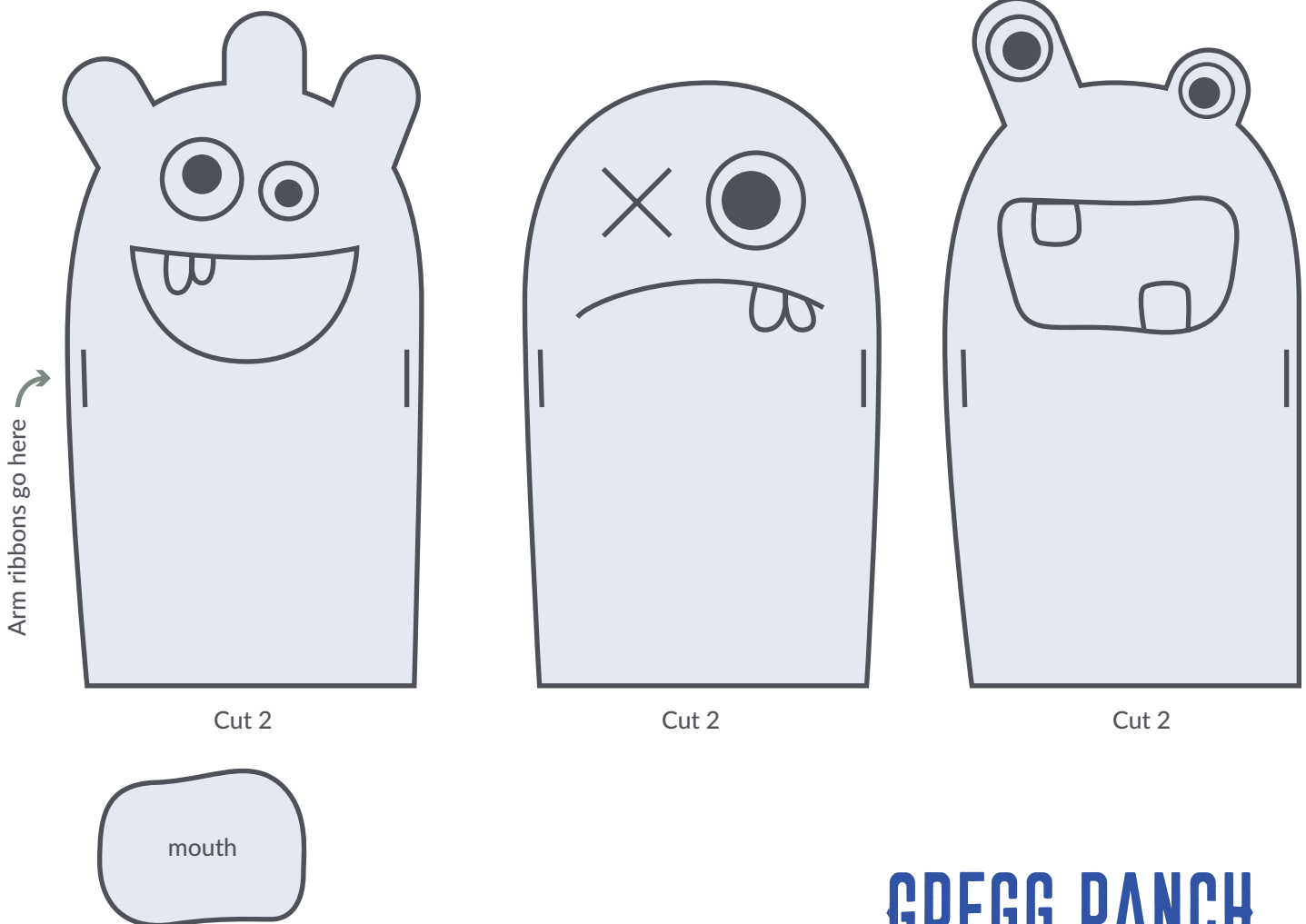
On the top body piece, sew on a heart-shaped button where the heart would be.

Using felt scraps, sew on a smile, teeth, or whatever you like, using embroidery thread and a simple stab stitch. You can add buttons, or a simple embroidered smile – making your monster your own!

Cut about 16" of ¼" ribbon, and lay flat on the back body piece, centered. Pin the top body piece to the back, so the ribbon won't slip. Using a simple blanket stitch, sew the top body piece to the back body piece. Catch the ribbon as you sew around your monster. (Here, you might need to use a stab stitch.) Be sure to leave the bottom open for your finger.

Glue on googly eyes last.

To make the monster hug, tie a treat to the monster. What's not to love?!
