

INSTRUCTIONS: Dressed Up Easter Eggs

SUPPLIES:

Cut outs printed on cover paper
Scissors
Glue or tape
Hardboiled or plastic, filled Eggs
Markers

BUNNY EARS

Cut out bunny ears on page 2, take the two ends and form a circle. Hold it around your egg so it fits well, then overlap and glue or tape the two end pieces together.

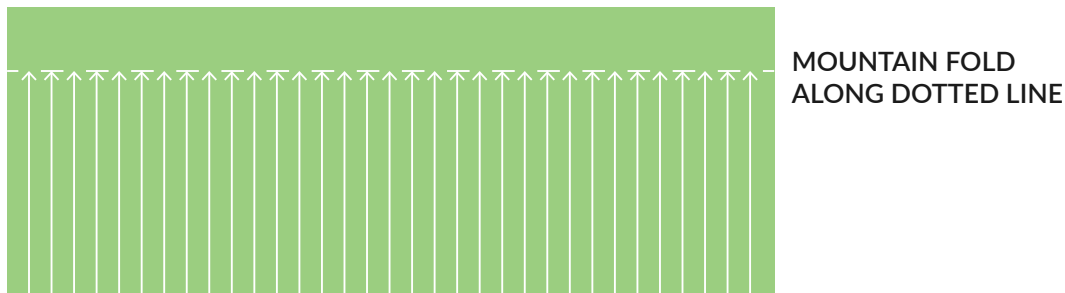
BUNNY FEET

Cut out the bunny feet on page 2, and fold the feet up (see dotted line below). Take the two ends and form a circle. Hold it around your egg so it fits well, then overlap and glue or tape the two end pieces together.



GRASS SKIRT

Cut out the green rectangle on page 2, fold where the arrow indicates, cut slits vertically (see below) until you reach the fold. Bring the ends together to make a circle and glue or tape the ends together to complete the grass skirt. Make sure it is fitted to the size of your egg.



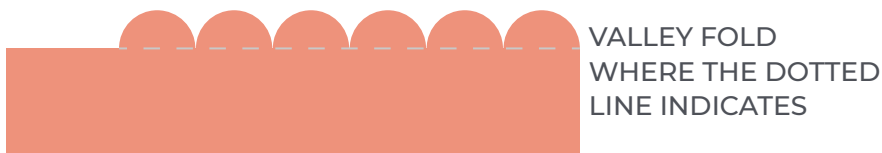
CUT GRASS BLADES VERTICALLY UNTIL YOU REACH THE FOLD

CROWN

Cut out the crown on page 2. Take the two ends and form a circle. Hold it around your egg so it fits well, then overlap and glue or tape the two end pieces together.

FLOWER DRESS

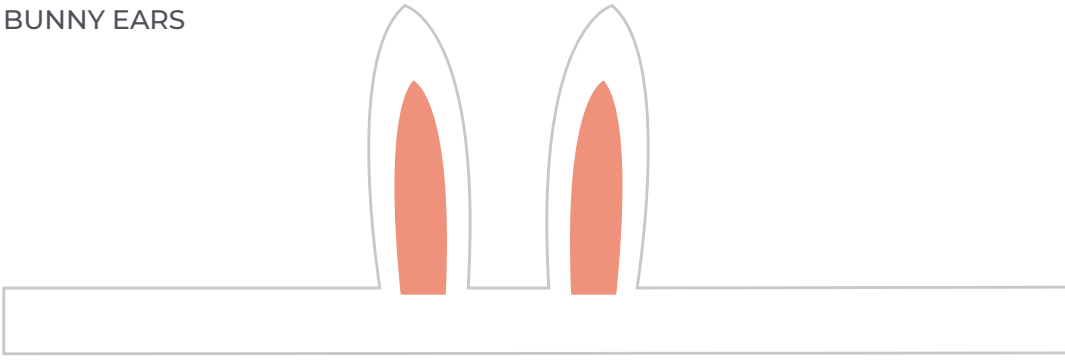
Cut out the flower dress on page 2, and fold the petals out (see below). Take the two ends and form a circle. Hold it around your egg so it fits well, then overlap and glue or tape the two end pieces together.



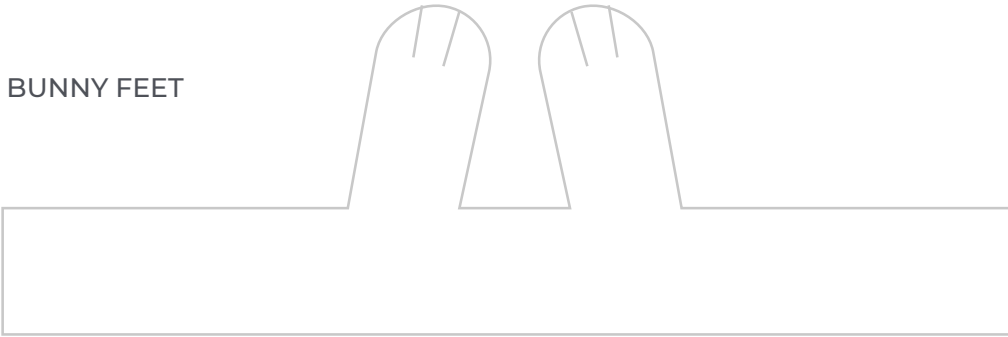

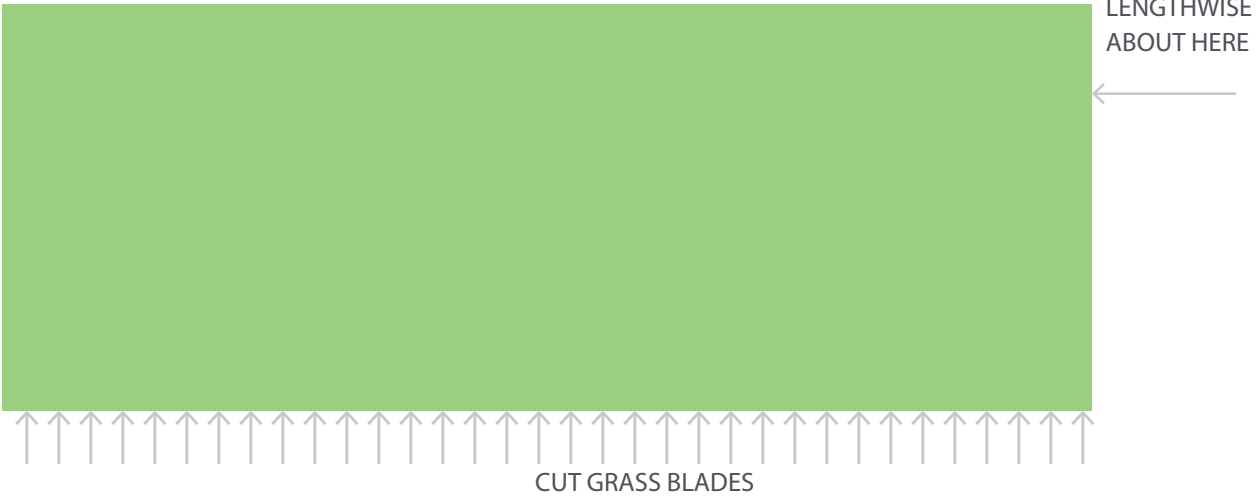

BUNNY FEET

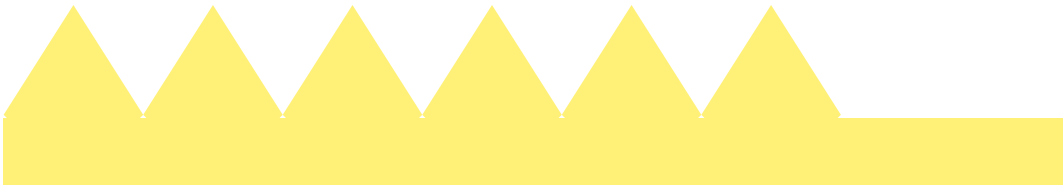


GRASS SKIRT
