

INSTRUCTIONS: Easter Bunny & Carrot Cufflinks

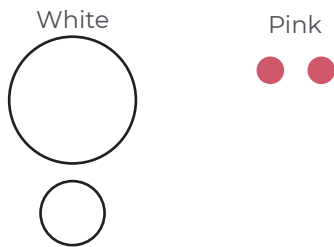
SUPPLIES:

Recycled cufflinks from dry cleaners
White, pink, orange & green polymer clay
Small rounding and cutting tools
Skewer or something similar to poke hole

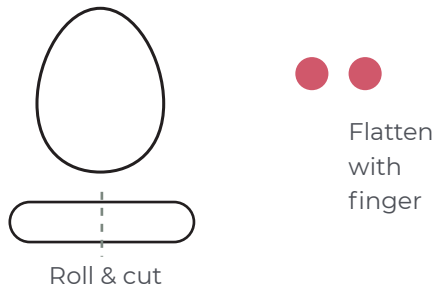
Black Acrylic paint with small round brush
E6000 glue
Spray Varathane
Oven

BUNNY

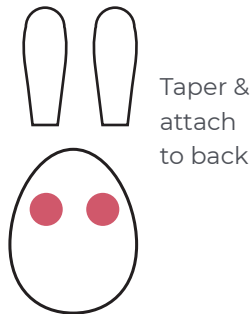
- 1 Make ball shapes with your polymer clay, about this size



- 2 Egg shape



- 3 Taper & attach to back



- 4 Make small dent with any small rounded tool



- 5 Lay foil on a rack and use a knife to make small slit in foil. Press cufflink through so it "hangs". Bake at 275° for 15 minutes.

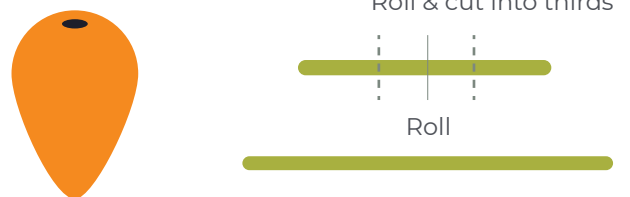
- 6 Paint faces with black acrylic paint. Spray lightly with spray Varathane. Glue with E6000 glue onto cufflinks.

CARROT

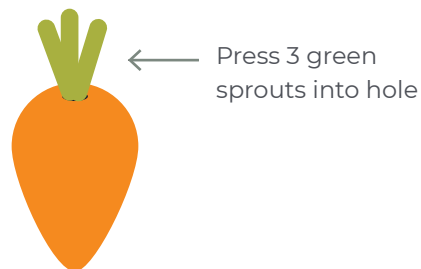
- 1 Make ball shapes with your polymer clay, about this size



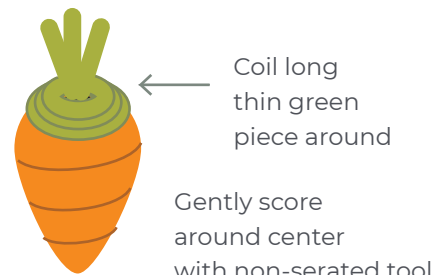
- 2 Make small hole in top with skewer



- 3 Press 3 green sprouts into hole



- 4 Coil long thin green piece around
