

INSTRUCTIONS: Lawn Golf Alebrijes

YOU WILL NEED:

- These alebrije cut-outs
- Cardboard or foam core
- Scissors or x-acto knife
- Paint

STEP 1

Print and carefully cut out desired animal pieces; have fun mixing and matching! Trace onto cardboard or foam core and cut out. Make sure to cut out two leg pieces so the assembled alebrije is stable.

STEP 2

Cut along the dashed lines to create slits; this is how the alebrije will be assembled later. The dashed lines on the back of the body are optional and only need to be cut if you want to attach more body parts.

STEP 3

Paint your alebrije!

STEP 4

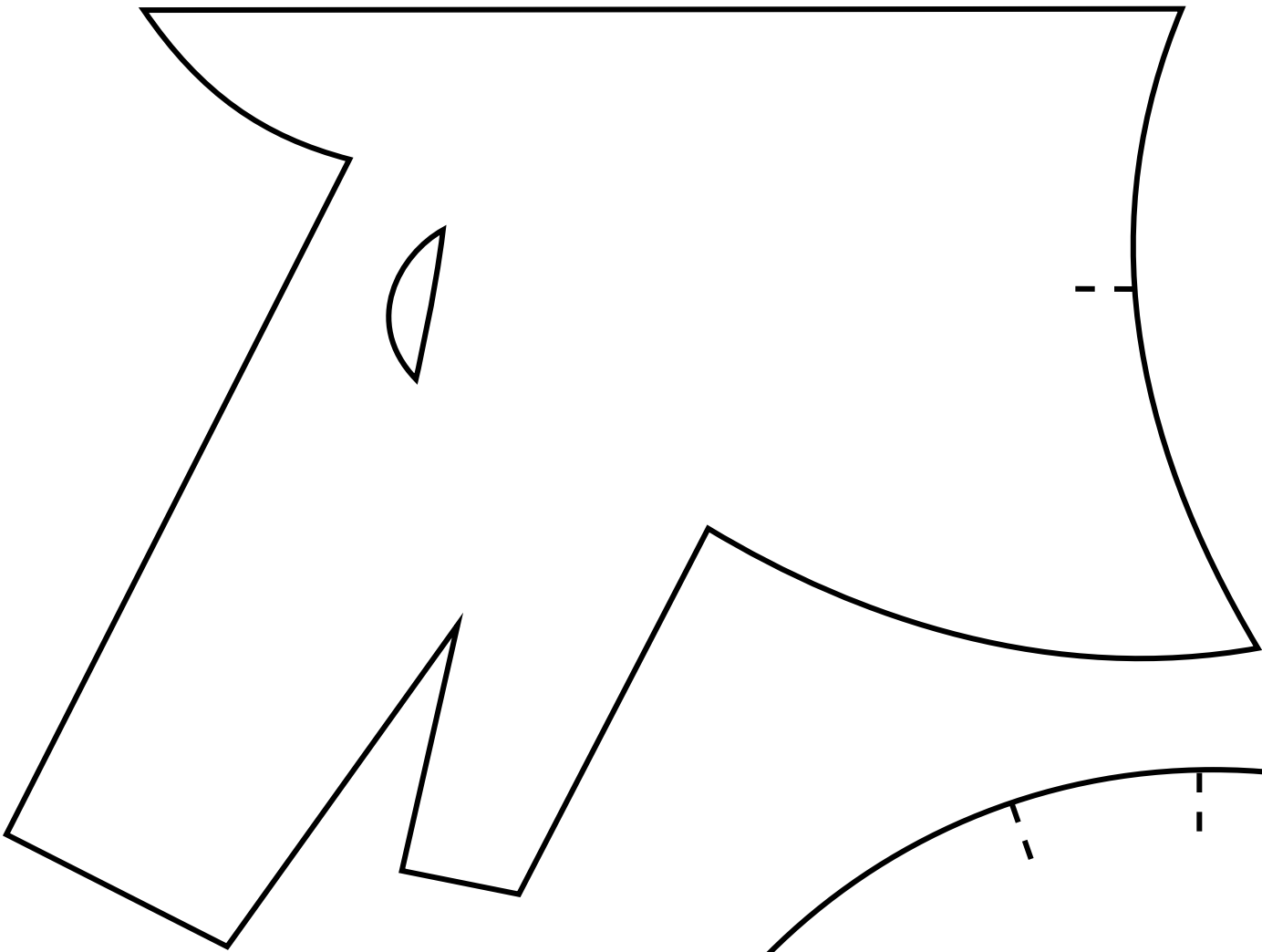
Assemble your alebrije by sliding the pieces together at the slits. Attach the head and tail, as well as horns, ears, and wings, to connector pieces first and then the connector to the body. Attach scales and legs directly to the body.

STEP 5

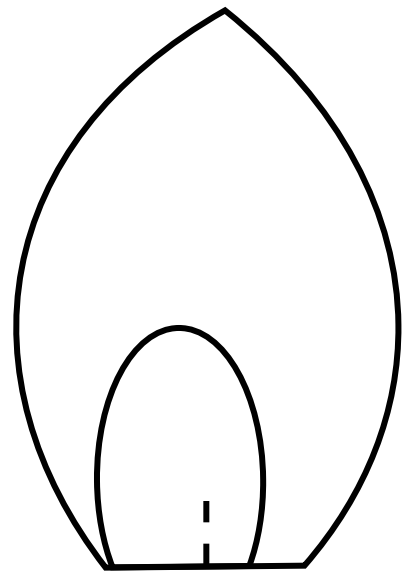
Congratulations!
