# **INSTRUCTIONS**: Feather Wreath

### YOU WILL NEED:

- Templates provided for 3 feather sizes, with and without feather design
- · Styrofoam or floral foam ring
- · Paper you can use heavy or regular weight, any colors you like
- Scissors
- · Glue
- · String, twine or ribbon for hanging

## STEP 1

Print enough of the fether templates to fill the wreath; how many depends on the wreath's size. For a 10 inch ring we used 5 pages of large feathers, 3 pages of medium feathers, and 2 pages of small feathers.

We liked some white space in our design and printed roughly twice as many blank feathers as decorated feathers, but it's up to you!

## STEP 2

Cut out the feathers and then fold them all the way up the center line to create a tent shape. You can also fold the feathers first and then cut along the dotted line to make cutting twice as fast!

## STEP 3

Tie your twine to the ring for hanging.

#### STEP 4

Starting with the large feathers first, glue the bottom tab of each feather toward the inside edge of the ring. Space the feathers pretty evenly; it's ok if there are some gaps, you'll cover them with your medium and small feathers.

Let dry. We set a medium sized book on the ring as it dried to prevent the feathers from popping up.

### STEP 5

Glue the medium feathers to the ring in the same way. Let dry. Finish by adding the smallest feathers.

And there you have it! A lovely feather wreath!
