

INSTRUCTIONS: Tooth Fairy Envelopes

SUPPLIES

- White construction paper or cardstock
- White glue
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print the instructions, one "To: Tooth Fairy" and one "From: Tooth Fairy" envelope; print double-sided.
2. Cut out the envelopes and envelope seals along the dashed lines.
3. Fill out the forms on the insides of the envelopes before assembling; the "To: Tooth Fairy" form will be filled by the lucky kid who lost a tooth. The "From: Tooth Fairy" form will be filled out by the Tooth Fairy herself.
4. Assemble the envelope by folding the side flaps inward along the solid line, then fold and glue the bottom flap over the side flaps.
5. Once envelopes have been filled, either with a tooth-filled pouch or the Tooth Fairy's gift, apply glue to the back of the envelope seal and use to glue the envelope closed.
